a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Matild Palace underwent an extensive five-year renovation led by award-winning interior designer Maria Vafiadis and local architects Péter Dajka and Puhl Antal, reborn as a modern luxury hotel in 130 rooms.

Maria Vafiadis, founder of MKV Design studio, designed the interiors of the hotel to preserve the historical heritage of the palace in various decorative elements, highlighting the central location of the Matild Palace just a stone's throw from the Danube. The impressive design reflects the palace's legendary past as the epicenter of social life on the map of Budapest. The modern and elegant interior design of the hotel will impress even the most discerning guests and leave a vivid mark in their memory.

The majestic Matild Palace was built 120 years ago during the Belle Époque era at the behest of Her Imperial and Royal Highness Maria Clotilde of Saxe-Coburg-Gotha, and its walls preserve memories of the high society of Budapest at that time. The Matild Palace was one of two Baroque palaces that served as a gateway to the famous Elisabeth Bridge. Initially, it housed cafes, shops and galleries, and on the upper floors there were living quarters.
